Governance Processes and Procedures

Student Achievement

(Last Updated: 20/11/2009)

- 1) In consultation with the school staff the board will set the annual achievement targets for the school.
- 2) Nominated curriculum reviews and student achievement reports will be presented to the board as timetabled in the annual agenda.
- 3) The board specifically delegates to the principal as his prime responsibility the provision of educational programmes that are of a high standard and the monitoring and evaluation of student progress and achievement.
- 4) The board will be proactive in ensuring that the school has high expectations of its students and that school curriculum programmes and class teaching are of a high standard.
