### **Treaty Obligations**

(Last Updated: 20/11/2009)

- 1) The composition of the board will reflect New Zealand's dual cultural heritage.
- 2) The decisions of the board will reflect New Zealand's dual cultural heritage.
- 3) The board will actively seek out the views of its Maori parents.
- 4) The board will regularly liaise with the whanau support group and receive reports from them.
- 5) The board will also consult with the school kaumatua as required, recognising his important role in the life of the school.
- 6) The board through the principal will ensure that aspects of Maori language and culture are evident in the school and its programmes.
- 7) The board in its decisions will also consider the wishes and aspirations of those parents from other ethnic or national backgrounds.
