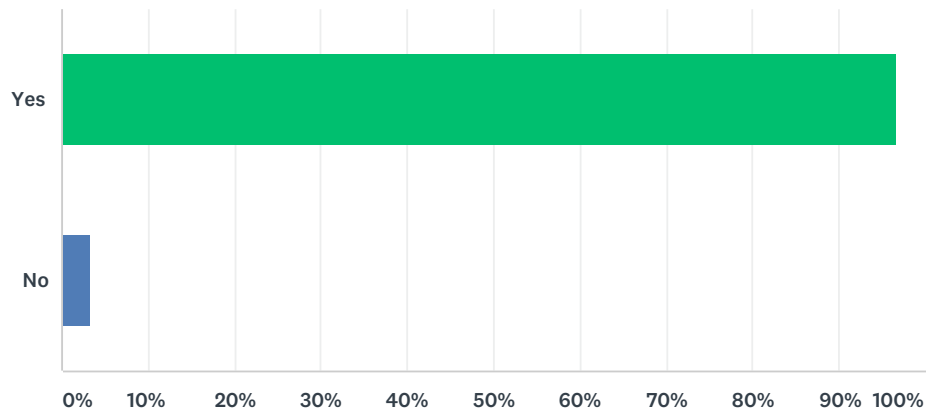


Q1 Would you like your child to learn te reo maori at Koromatua School?

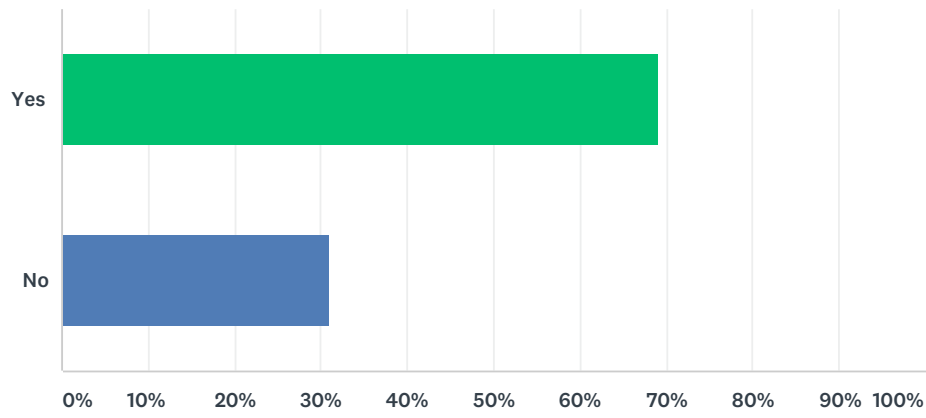

Q2 Do you think learning te reo maori should be compulsory for all students?

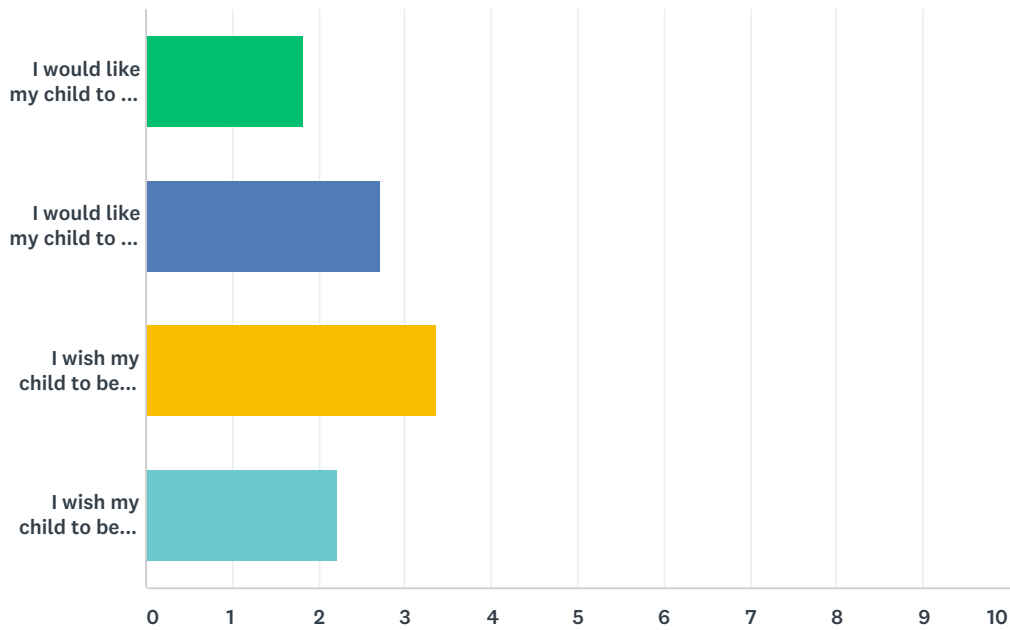

Q3 If you answered “Yes” to Question 1 (you wish your child to learn te reo maori), please rank the following options (first, second, third, fourth)

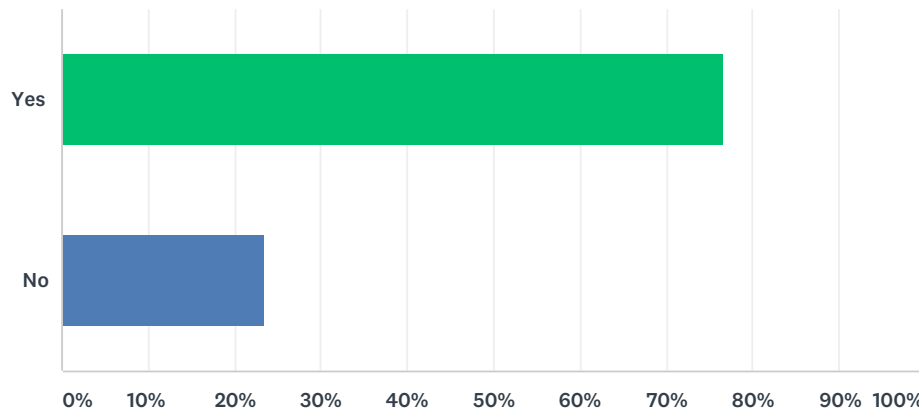

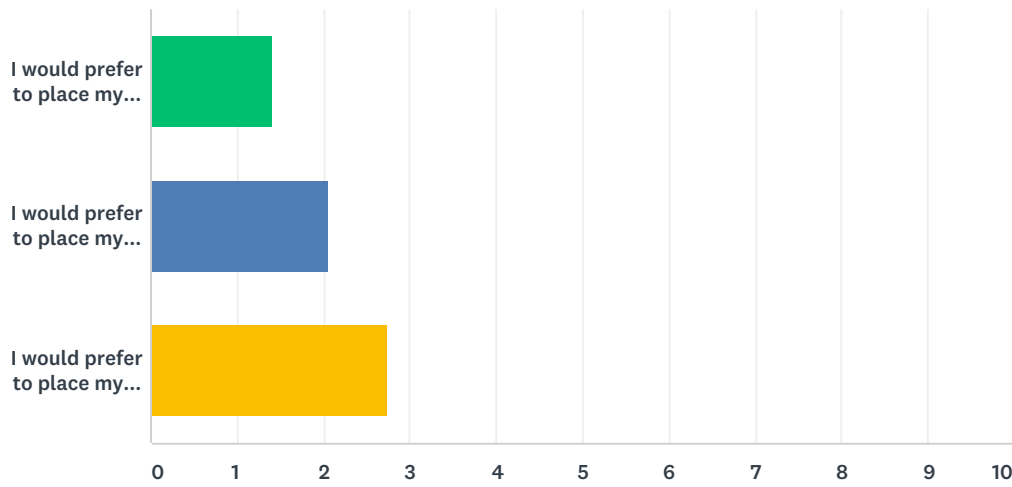

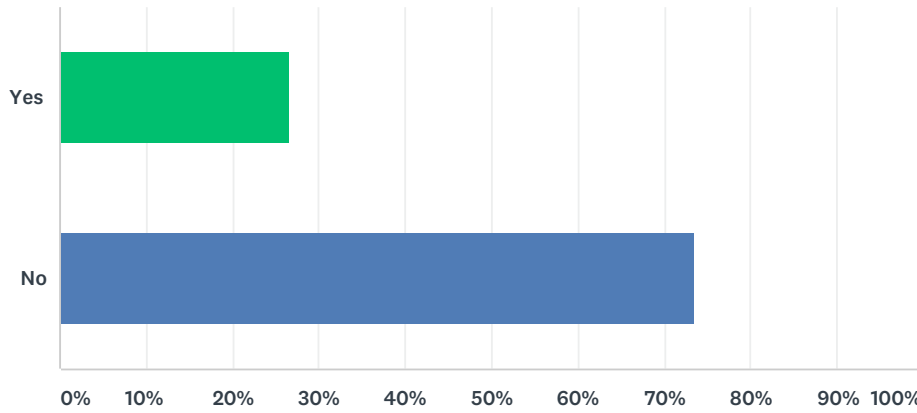

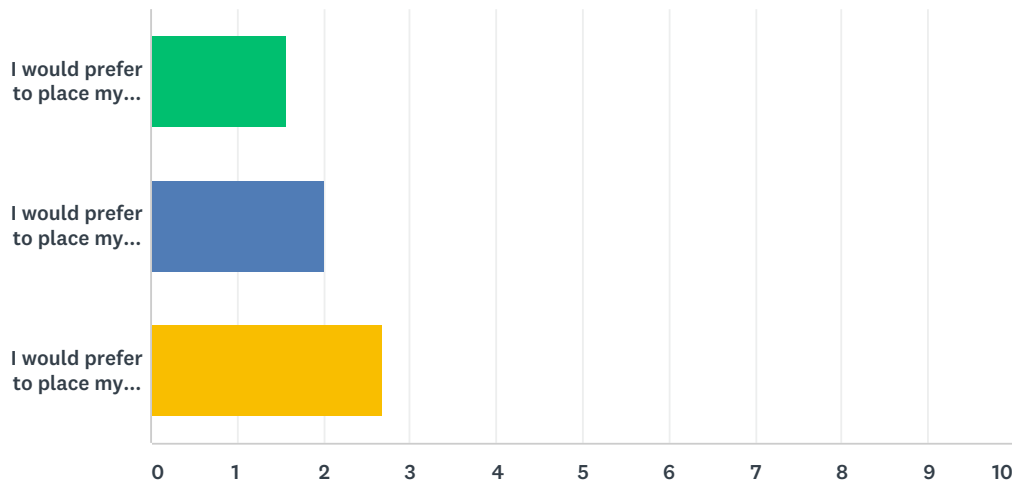

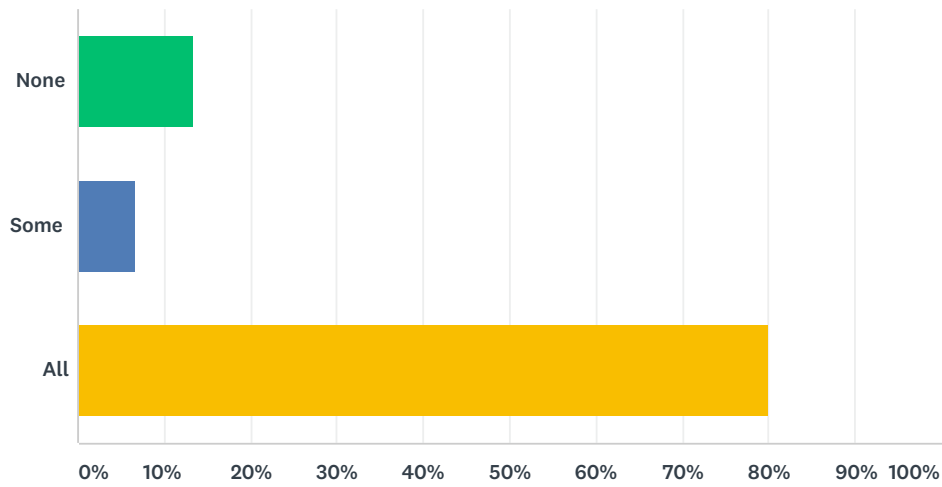

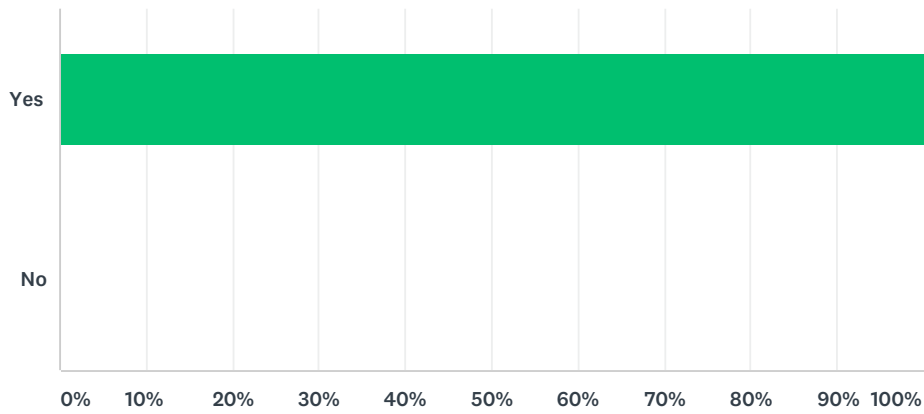

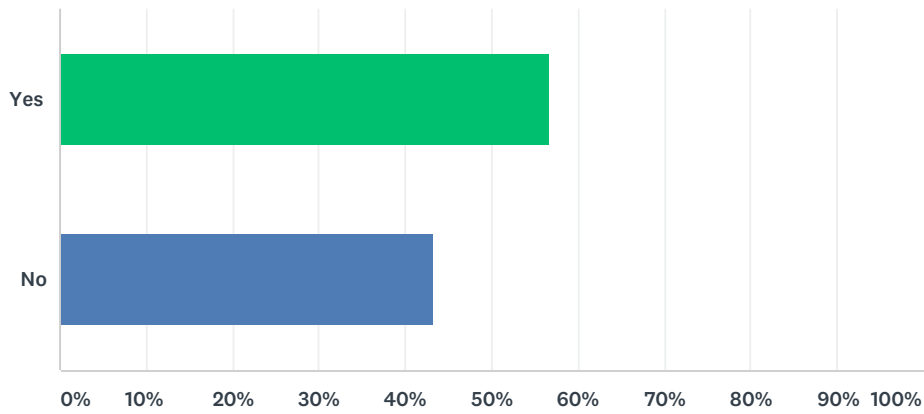

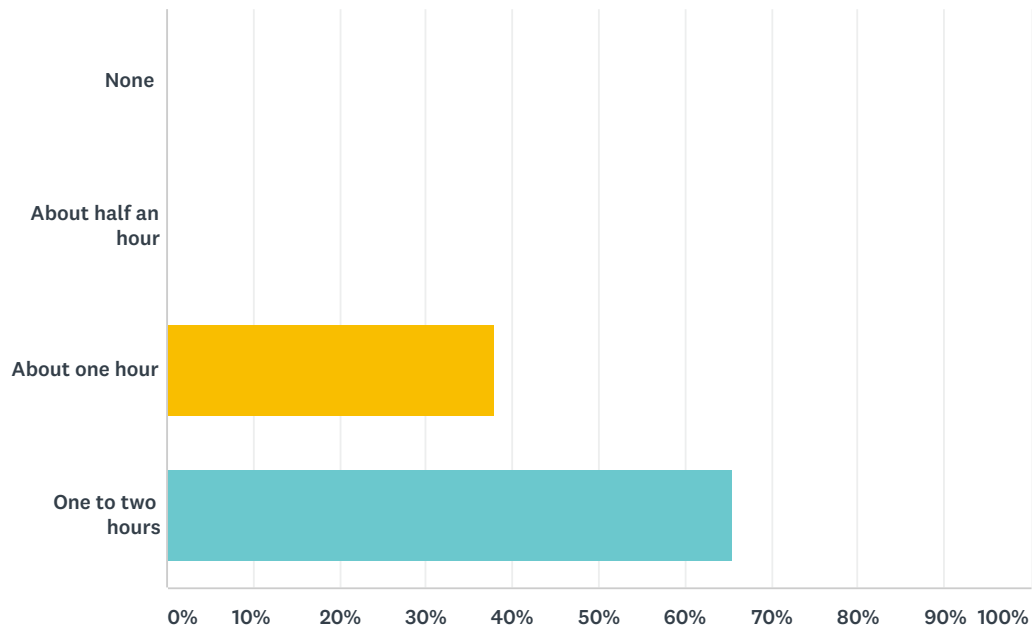

Q11 How many hours per week would you like to see dedicated to learning kapahaka?

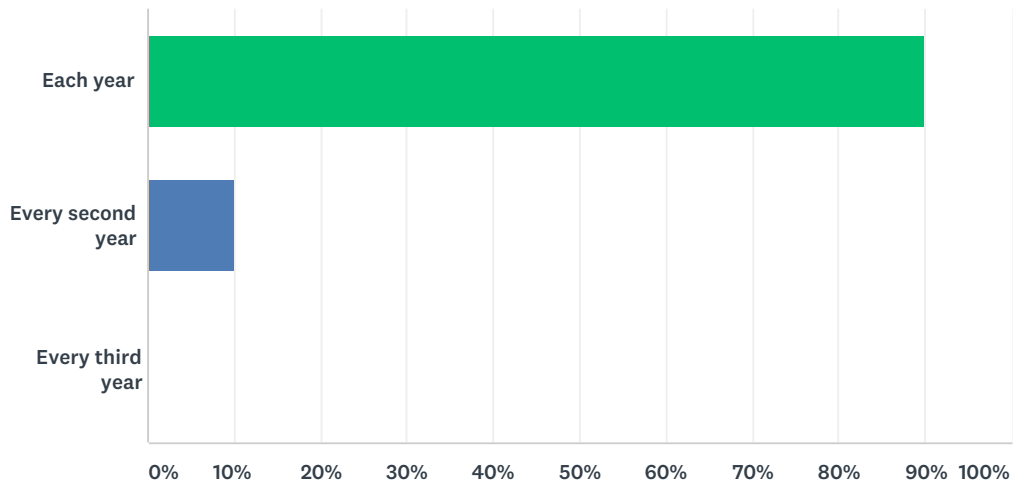

Q12 How often would you like to see a school kapahaka show?

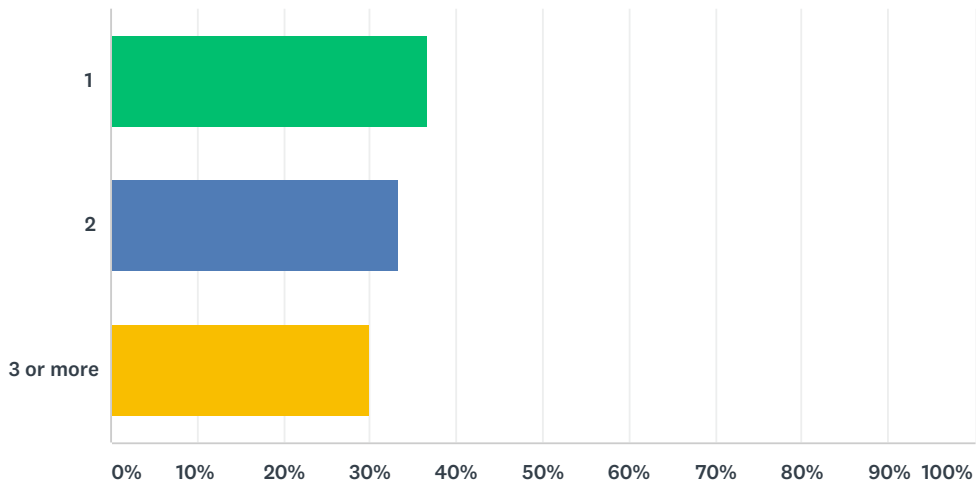

Q13 How many children do you have at Koromatua School?

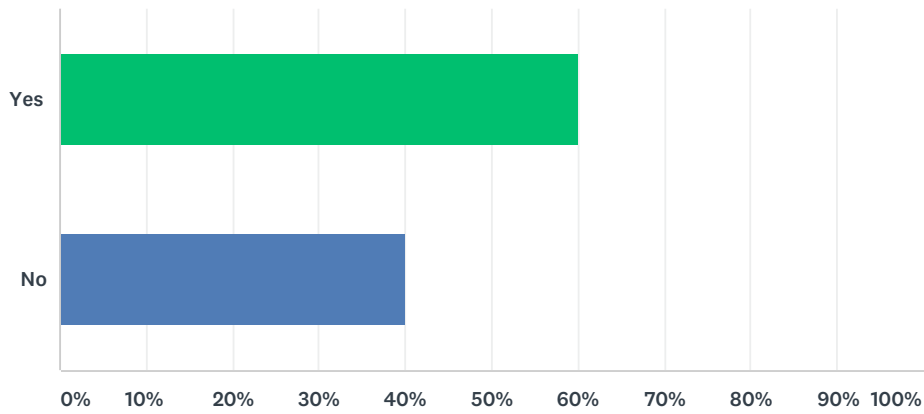

Q14 Is anyone at home learning te reo maori?

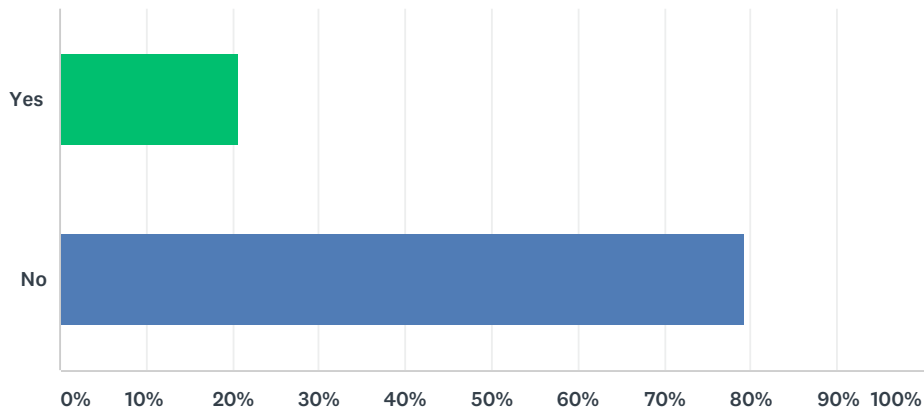

Q15 Is anyone at home a fluent speaker of te reo maori?

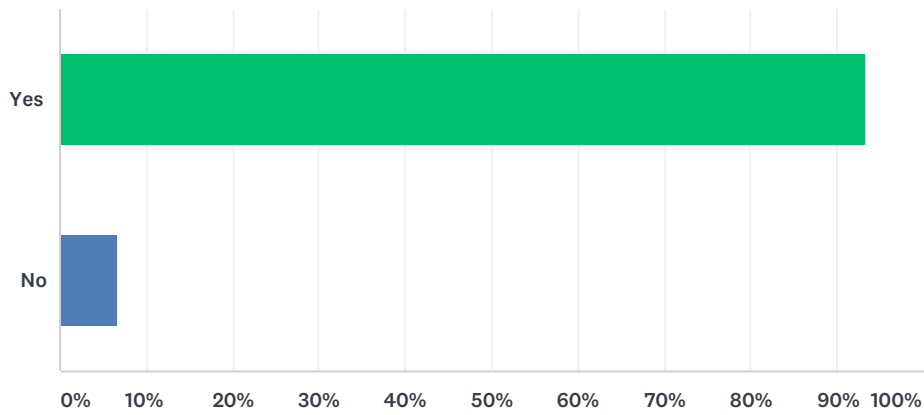

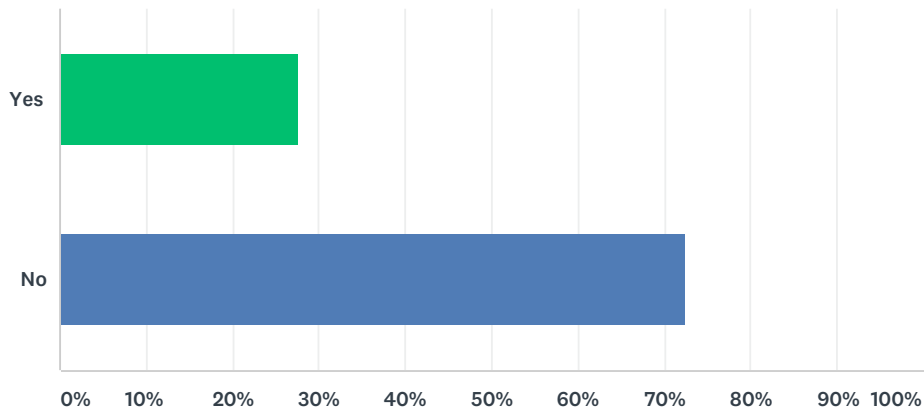

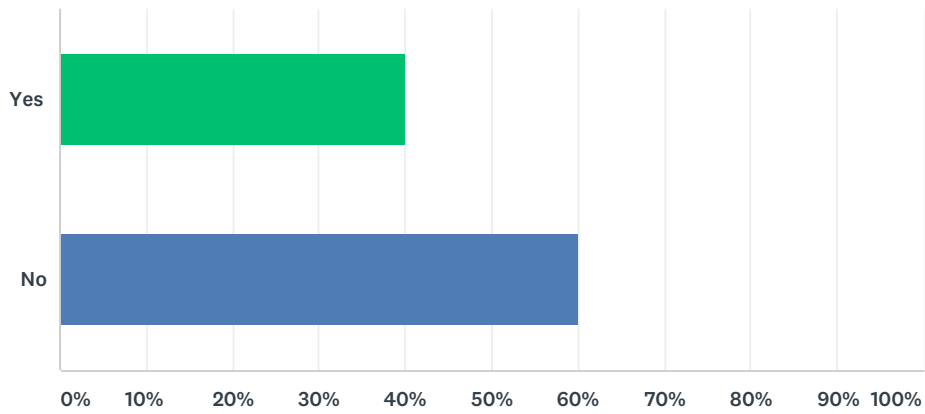

Q18 Is anyone at home involved with kapahaka?

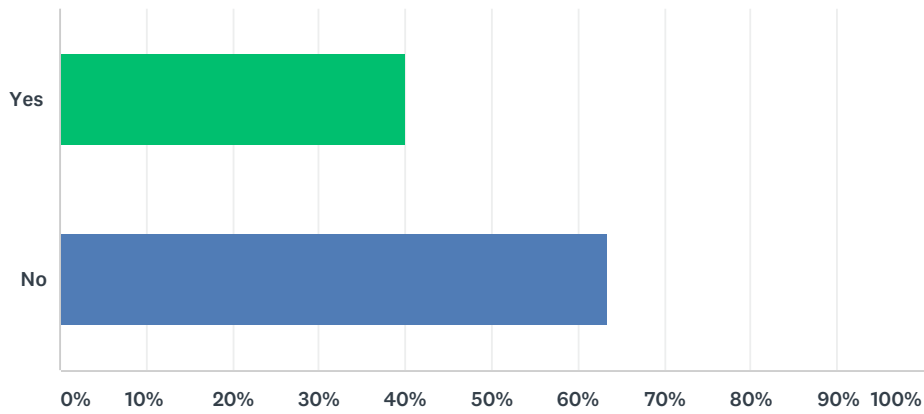
