Melville Year 7-13 College

In May, the Minister of Education announced that Melville High School and Melville Intermediate School would close at the end of 2023 and a new Year 7-13 College would open at the start of 2024.

An Establishment Board (ESB) has been appointed by the Minister and they have the exciting challenge of leading the reset of education in the Melville area and making the new school, the school of choice.

Extensive community consultation was carried out between 2019 – 2021 and the ESB will be looking for further consultation as they work through issues such as school name, school vision, values and uniform.
